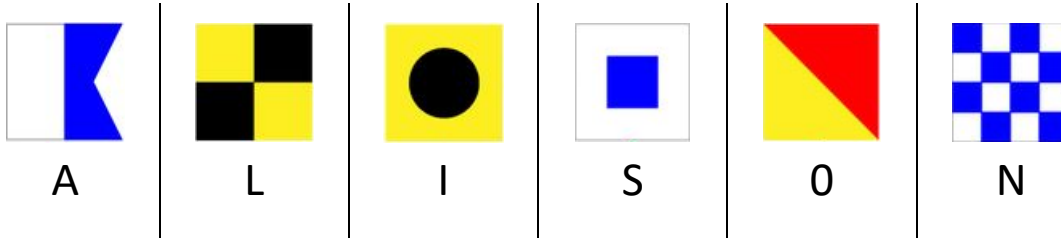


Nautical Signalling Pennants































Signalling pennants are flags which are used to communicate with ships.
